**ORDER**

Imphal, the 22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2014

No. 2/1/RTE/2013-MCPCR : The Manipur Commission for Protection of Child Rights (MCPCR) has been entrusted with the duties of monitoring of Child's Rights to Education as defined under the RTE Act, 2009. Attention of the Manipur Commission for Protection of Child Rights has been attracted for screening of children in admission in schools (Elementary education) under Section 13 (2) (b) of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

The power and functions conferred under Section 13 (1) of the Commission for Protection of Child Rights Act, 2005 read with Section 13(2)(b) of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, this Commission is of the view that the school admission test system for admission to primary classes are against the RTE Act, 2009 and a very serious violation of the Act. Such schools practicing admission tests system should be de-recognized under the RTE, Act.

It is hereby directed to all schools located in Manipur State to refrain from resorting to any screening procedure for admission to elementary classes keeping in tune with the mandate under Section 13 (1) of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act. Any screening procedure already started for admission to elementary classes in any school should be suspended with immediate effect.

Send a copy of this order to all the concerned District Education Officers to take necessary action if any school is found violating the provisions of the Act, and issue show cause notice to all defaulting schools why necessary action shall not be taken against them for infraction of the law of this land made for the best interest of the children.
