Sir,

Kind reference is invited to this office letter No. REC/DDUGJY/2016-17/1588 dated 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2017 vide which it has been requested to confirm the status of electrification level of Schools in the State to enable us taking up with State/Power Utilities for extending electricity access to those schools, bereft of electricity connections.

The Ministry of Human Resources Development (MHRD) vide letter dated 21<sup>st</sup> Feb, 2017 have informed that in Rural areas of the State, 2,737 Schools are still running without electricity supply connections (copy of the letter is enclosed as **Annexure – I**).

It may be informed that DeenDayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY) covers all aspects of rural power distribution viz., Feeder Segregation, Strengthening and augmentation of sub-transmission & distribution infrastructure, Micro-grid and Off-grid distribution network, Metering of distribution transformers/feeders/consumers and Rural Electrification works which supplement overall rural development and facilitate towards '24x7 Power For All' in the Country. In village electrification, extending electricity infrastructure to public places like Panchayat Offices, Community Centres, Schools & Health Centres etc. is a vital component under DDUGJY paving improvement in socio-economic development of rural areas.

In above light, it is requested to reconcile the data on District-wise number of Schools without electricity connections in rural areas of the State as per enclosed format (Annexure –II) and kindly arrange to send to us for taking necessary action for providing electricity infrastructure for un-electrified Schools.
