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

No. 5/3/1-1)/07/DE(S)(Ex): It is hereby notified for information to all concerned that the Qualifying Examination for admission to Rashtriya Indian Military College, Dehradun for the Term Commencing January 2019 will be held on 1st & 2nd June, 2018 at Ram Lal Paul Hr. Sec. School, Imphal.

Male students who are reading in Class – VII or VII Passed from any recognized School and born between 2nd January 2006 and 1st Jul 2007 is eligible for admission in January 2019 term.

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PRESS RELEASE FOR NEXT RIMC ADMISSION TEST IN JUN 2018
PRESS INFORMATION BUREAU (DEFENCE WING) GOVERNMENT OF INDIA

1. The Rashtriya Indian Military College is an Inter-Services Institution and a Category 'A' establishment of the Ministry of Defence. The College was established in 1922 with the primary aim of preparing the boys for entry into Defence Services and to provide quality all round education to young boys.

2. Applications are invited for **boys only** for admission to **Class VIII** in the Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC), Dehradun (UK) for **Jan 2019 Term** which will be conducted at selected centres on **01 (Fri) and 02 (Sat) Jun 2018**.

3. **Entry Age.** Candidates (boys only) appearing for the above test should not be less than 11½ years in age but should not have attained the age of 13 years as on **01 Jan 2019**, i.e., they should have been born not earlier than **02 Jan 2006** and not later than **01 Jul 2007**.

4. **Educational Qualifications.** Candidates should either be studying in **Class VII** or **passed Class VII** from any recognized school at the time of admission to the RIMC, i.e. on **01 Jan 2019**.

5. **Scheme of Examination.** The examination comprises of:-

(a) **Written Examination.** The written part of the examination will consist of three papers, namely, **English** (1000-1200hrs) and **Mathematics** (1400-1530hrs) shall be conducted on **01 (Fri) Jun 2018** and **General Knowledge paper** (1000-1100hrs) on **02 (Sat) Jun 2018**. **Minimum pass marks in each paper is 50%.**

(b) **Viva Voce.** The interview date shall be **04 (Thu) Oct 2018**, and interview will be held for only those candidates who qualify in the written exam, **Minimum pass marks in the interview is 50%** and the date, venue for interview will be intimated to them by respective States by first week of **Sep 2018**. **Intelligence and personality** of the candidates will be tested in the interview.

(c) **Medical Examination.** All the candidates qualified after interview will undergo a medical examination at selected Military Hospitals and only those candidates found medically fit will be considered for selection and admission to the RIMC. The medical examination of the candidates forms only a part of the system of selection and does not imply the final selection.

Note:

- ◆ As per the Government of India, Ministry of Defence letter No A/36105/GS/MT-6/D(GS-II) dated 03 Sep 2014, the wards of Central Government employees can undertake their exam and viva-voce at the place of posting of employee/ domicile state. However, their domicile will be as per original domicile state and accordingly, their candidature will also be considered as per the state of domicile.
 - ◆ The interviews will be held for only those candidates who pass the written exam; their list will be sent to the respective State Governments by RIMC after approval of MT Directorate.
 - ◆ It is mandatory for all the selected candidates (including candidates from all India Reserve Merit List, if selected) to join RIMC within 10 days of commencement of term as per the joining instructions. If the selected candidate fails to join within 10 days, his candidature will be cancelled and next reserve candidate will be called to join.
 - ◆ Vacancies for Jan Term 2019, in all respect will be filled by 30 Jan 2019. No candidate will be allowed to join RIMC after 30 Jan 2019 under any circumstances (incl medical).
 - ◆ Results and joining instructions will be regularly updated on RIMC website. It is candidate's responsibility to check the status regularly.
6. **Examination Centres.** Examination centres are generally located in the **state capitals** or in cities/towns as advertised.
7. **Fee.** Fees at RIMC is heavily subsidized by the Central Govt. The fee is presently **Rs. 42,400/-** per year. It may increase from time to time. At the time of entry a Security Deposit of **Rs. 20,000/-** is to be made. This is refunded when the boy passes out.
8. **Scholarships.** Scholarships are granted by various state Govts to meritorious students. The amount of scholarships varies from state to state and is in between **Rs. 10,000/-** to **Rs. 20,000/-** per annum. Continuation of S scholarship once granted by the state is subject to merit, income and discipline of the cadet and his performance during the year.
9. **The Application Forms.** The prospectus-cum-application form and booklet of old question papers can be obtained from **The Rashtriya Indian Military College, Garhi Cantt, Dehradun, Uttarakhand, Pin - 248003** through speed post by forwarding self addressed slip and an account payee bank demand draft of **Rs. 600/-** for General Candidates **Rs. 555/-** for SC/ST candidates along with Caste Certificate. The demand draft will be made in favour of **"THE COMMANDANT RIMC DEHRADUN", DRAWEE BRANCH, STATE BANK OF INDIA, TEL BHAVAN, DEHRADUN, (BANK CODE-01576), UTTARAKHAND**. The address should be TYPED / WRITTEN clearly in CAPITAL LETTERS with pin code and contact number. The delay on part of postal department is not the responsibility of this institution.

Note:

- ◆ The application forms issued by RIMC only shall be valid. Locally printed / Photocopied and without RIMC hologram (Seal) forms shall not be accepted.
 - ◆ No refund of the application fee on any condition.
10. **Last Date.** Applications in duplicate on prescribed form accompanied by documents to be attached with application form **two passport size photographs, Domicile Certificate of the candidate, Birth Certificate (issued by Municipal Corporation/Gram Panchayat, SC, ST Certificate and Certificate from principal of the School in original with photograph on it attested stating date of birth and in which Class studying.** Application forms should reach the **respective State Governments** (as specified in the press note) of which their parents /guardians are domicile of, by **31 Mar 2018**. The wards of Central Government employees, in order to verify the antecedents of such candidates, the State (where such candidates intend taking the written test) are free to ask for service certificates over and above the routine documentation. The States where the candidates appear must also satisfy themselves with respect to place of duty of the parent/guardian. Other than the above, states are to ensure that no other candidate must be allowed to appear for the written examination in a state other than which the candidate is domicile of. **Kindly note the application forms must be sent to the State Govts and not to the Rashtriya Indian Military College, Dehradun, Uttarakhand.**
