Imphal, dated the 21st September, 1981.

No.1/97/75-RR/DP: In supersession of all previous orders in this regard and in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Manipur hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of (1) Head of Junior High Schools, (2) Asst. Head Master of High Schools and (3) Superintendent, B.T.I. of the Education Department, Manipur as shown in MPSC Form-8 namely:-

1. Short title:- These rules may be called the Education Department, Government of Manipur / (1) Head Master of Junior High Schools, (2) Assistant Head Master of High Schools and (3) Superintendent, B.T.I.) Recruitment Rules, 1981.

2. Application:- These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the M.P.S.C. Form - 8 hereto annexed.

3. Classification, scale of pay, method of recruitment etc.:- Classification of the said posts, scale of pay, method of recruitment and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in the columns 3 to 13 of the said M.P.S.C. Form-8.

4. Disqualification:- (a) No person, who has more than one wife living or who having a spouse living, marries in any case in which such marriage is void by reason of its taking place during the life-time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment to the aforesaid posts, and


(b) no woman whose marriage is void by reason of husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who has a wife living at the time of such marriage, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts.

Provided that the Governor of Manipur may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for so ordering, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. "Power to relax. Where the Governor is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation of the Manipur Public Service Commission, for relaxation of any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts".

6. These rules shall come into force with immediate effect.



PROMOTION:

- 1) Graduate Teachers of Junior High School/High School/Higher Secondary School with 5(five) years regular service in the grade if he is a B.T. or B.Ed. or its equivalent from a recognised University/Institute and with 8(eight) years regular service if he is none.
- 2) Theory Instructor(Graduate) of B.T.I. with the same length of the Service as prescribed in the case of Graduate Teachers.

Class II D.P.C.

As required under MPSC (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 1972.

Explanation:- (1) The term Graduate Teacher includes Hindi Teachers of the Junior High Schools, High Schools and Higher Secondary Schools possessing requisite qualifications as prescribed for the ordinary Graduate Teachers above.

(2) Equivalent of B.T./B.Ed. includes Hindi Shiksha Parangat.

NOTES:-1. Where a person is considered for such appointment all persons possessing the requisite qualifications and who are senior to him in the grade shall also be considered irrespective of the fact whether or not they fulfil the requirement as to the minimum period of qualifying service for promotion prescribed above.

2. Any period of ad-hoc appointment prior to the regularisation of their appointment in consultation with the Commission shall not be counted in the minimum period of service prescribed for promotion.
