No.5.2/1/07-DE(S)Pt-III: It is hereby informed to all the schools that the World Environment Day on the 5th June, 2019 (Wednesday) shall be celebrated by mass tree plantation in the school or appropriate locations as identified by the respective Schools across the state. The initiative jointly taken up by the Department of Education (Schools), Forest Department along with other stakeholders envisage to plant over 50000 saplings across the state in over 1000 schools.

It is also to further notify that all categories of schools (Private Schools, Government Aided Schools, Government Schools) can participate in the tree plantation programme.

The following broad guidelines be maintained/observed for participation in the mass tree plantation on World Environment Day:

- (i) The programme shall be held from 9.00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. in their respective school premises or in locations as identified by the schools.
- (ii) Number of saplings to be planted be submitted well in advance to the Directorate through the Nodal Officer Ibechaobi Laishram, SRO (9856651692) and Deepa Th, MES, Asstt. Director (9612021357).
- (iii) Forest Department will tie up with the Nodal/Link Teacher/Officer of the school for distribution of saplings.
- (iv) Proper announcement shall be made in the school assembly about the observation and that Name(s) of students/ class or names of the teachers and other persons may be projected/pasted on a suitable material against the trees so planted.
- (v) Schools (Students and Teachers) are to ensure the proper Preparation of the plantation sites/pits take place for the number of saplings prior to the plantation well in advance and kept ready latest by the 3rd of June, 2019.
- (vi) Whereever possible arrangements should be made saplings are protected from animals by having fencings or other arrangements.
- (vii) There shall be a review in the month of July for checking the survivality of saplings and subsequent replacemnt and another review in November for the number of surviving saplings.

Schools are to take proper care of the saplings planted and ensure their proper growth.
