

The Directorate of Education (Schools), Manipur in the interest of School students to keep them engaged in learning, during the period of the closure of Schools has initiated a number of measures. One such measure include organizing a number of competitions in scholastic (academic) as well as co-Scholastic/extra-curricular activities for *all students studying in Government Schools*. The competitions are class specific. All Government School students shall participate in at least 1 (one) category, if not more, of the competition(s).

2. During the period schools are closed, heads of schools and teachers of the respective schools shall ensure that information is disseminated to their students about various categories of competitions as indicated in the table below and their need for preparation accordingly.
