

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATE

FOR THE WRITTEN EXAMINATION, 2021

FOR ENGAGEMENT OF PRE PRIMARY TEACHERS AND GRADUATE TEACHERS UNDER
THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION(S)

1. The Written Examination for engagement of Pre Primary Teachers and Graduate Teachers will be conducted from 10 a.m. to 11.30 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. to 3.00 p.m. respectively on 14th August, 2021(Saturday).
2. Candidates would be allowed to enter in their examination hall/room 15 minutes before the commencement of the test. The Candidates are advised to reach their allotted test centres at least one hour in advance to check if their roll numbers need to be corrected. No candidates will be allowed to enter the test centre 5 minutes after the commencement of the test.
3. Test Booklet contains 100 questions carrying 1 mark each. Each question comprises four answers. The candidates will select the answer which he/she wants to mark on the answer Booklet provided.
4. There will be no penalty for wrong answers.
5. Answer/Response Test Booklet shall be distributed 5 (five) minutes ahead of the commencement of the test. Immediately after the commencement of the test, Candidates should check that the test Booklet does not have any unprinted or torn or missing pages or items, etc. If so, get it replaced by a complete new Test Booklet in consultation with the Invigilator(s).
6. Warning bell will be rung 5 minutes before the end of the test and after final bell and remain seated in their seats until the collection of the Test Booklet is completed.
7. Mobile phones or pagers or any other communication devices/ calculating devices and carry bags are not allowed inside the premises where the test is being conducted. Any infringement of these instructions should entail disciplinary action.
8. No candidates should misbehave in any manner or create disorderly scene in the test hall or harass the staff employed for the conduct of the test. Any such misconduct will be severely penalised. Candidates must strictly follow the instructions of the Supervisor/Asst. Supervisor/Invigilators.
9. Only blue/black ball point pen should be used for marking/ticking the answer and also for filling in the names of Candidate, Roll Number, etc.
10. Each question carries equal mark, the correct option/answer provided below each question. ONLY ONE answer should be chosen for each question.
11. Mark your responses/answers ONLY on Answer-Response Test Booklet by marking/ ticking a .
12. Answer-Response Test Booklet should be handed over to the Invigilator at the end of the Examination without fail before leaving the Examination Hall, failing which appropriate legal/criminal proceeding may be initiated against you.
13. No additional Blank Paper for rough is allowed inside the examination Hall. Sufficient Blank pages are appended in the Test Booklet for Rough Work.
