

**Minimum Essential Qualifications as per NCTE Norms:**

- (a) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known)  
or  
Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 45% marks and 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known), in accordance with NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations- 2002.  
or  
Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4-years Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.)  
or  
Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2-years Diploma in Education (Special Education)  
or  
Graduation and two-year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known)  
or  
Graduation with at least 50% marks and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.)  
or  
Post Gradation with a minimum 55% marks or equivalent grade and three-year integrated B.Ed-M.Ed.  
and
- (b) Pass in Teacher Eligibility Test (TET), to be conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

**Training to be undergone (As per NCTE norms):** A person-

- (a) With Graduation with at least 50% marks and B.Ed. qualification or with at least 45% marks and 1-year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.) in accordance with NCTE (Recognition norms and procedure) Regulations issued from time to time in this regard, shall also be eligible for appointment to Class-I to V upto 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2012, provided he/she undergoes, after appointment, an NCTE recognised 6-months Special Programme in Elementary Education;
- (b) With D.Ed (special Education) or B.Ed (special Education) qualification shall undergo, after appointment an NCTE recognised Special Programme in Elementary Education;
- (c) Who has acquired the qualification of three year integrated B.Ed-M.Ed from any National Council for Teacher Education recognised institution shall be considered for appointment as a teacher in Classes I to V:  
Provided that the person so appointed as a teacher shall mandatorily undergo a six-month Bridge course in Elementary Education recognised by the National Council for Teacher Education, within two years of such appointment as primary Teacher.

**Reservation Policy:** Relaxation upto 5% qualifying marks shall be allowed to the candidates belonging to reserved categories such as SC/ST/OBC/PH.
