
No. SM3/3/2022-EDN(S)-EDN(S): It has come to the notice of the Government that some of the teachers employed in the Department of Education-Schools, Government of Manipur have been either taking private tuitions or working in coaching centres or both.

2. Clause (a) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 15 of CCS Conduct Rules, 1964, states as below: "subject to the provisions of sub-rule (2), no Government servant shall, except with the previous sanction of the Government - engage directly or indirectly in any trade or business."

3. Section 28 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 also prohibits teachers to engage himself or herself in private tuition or private teaching activity.


4. Engaging in private tuitions/ coaching by Government Teachers without prior sanction of the Government is in violation of Rule 15(1)(a) of CCS Conduct Rules, 1964 and is liable for disciplinary action.

5. Therefore, in view of above and in order to ensure that quality education is being provided in the Schools, the Government has decided that strict disciplinary action will be initiated against Government Teacher found involved in providing coaching classes/ private tuitions.
