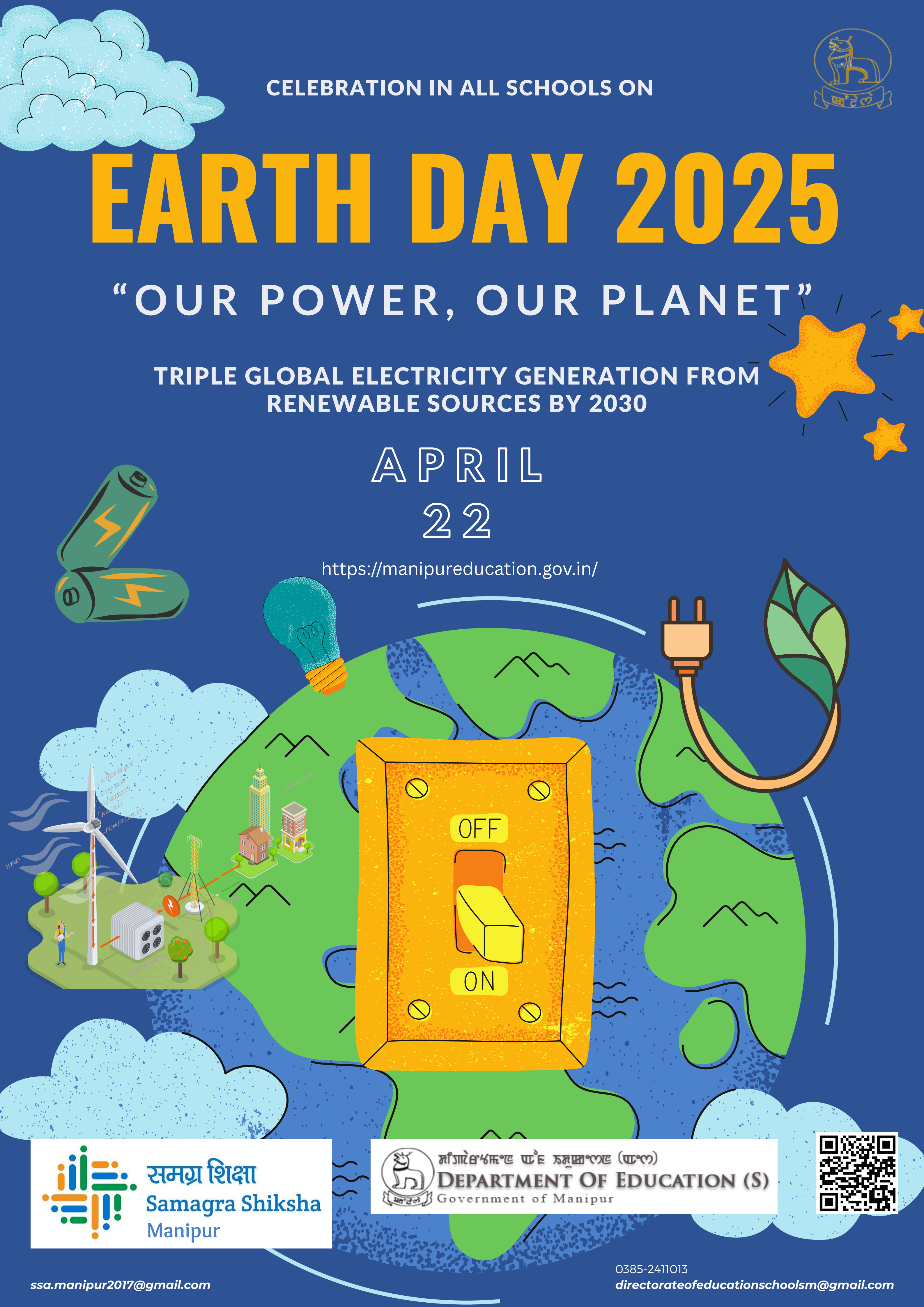

Suggestive activities for Schools on Earth Day. Schools would be requested to carry out the following suggestive activities as per students' level/grade.

1. Conduct plantation drives focusing on area specific flora.
2. Community Compost Initiative.
3. Vermicomposting Workshop.
4. Plastic Collection Drive.
5. Community Beatification Project.
6. Bottle Planting.
7. Organise cleanliness drives
8. Construct compost pits in schools to encourage waste segregation and use compost generated in the kitchen garden of the school.
9. Knowledge building sessions on renewable sources of energy may be organized in collaboration with NGOs, power departments etc.
10. Create posters, banners and other visual materials and paste on the school notice board to raise awareness about the importance of energy conservation.
11. Take "Say No to Single Use Plastic Items" Pledge - all students and teachers etc
